However, Box Offices will still be open on site to assist with purchases.

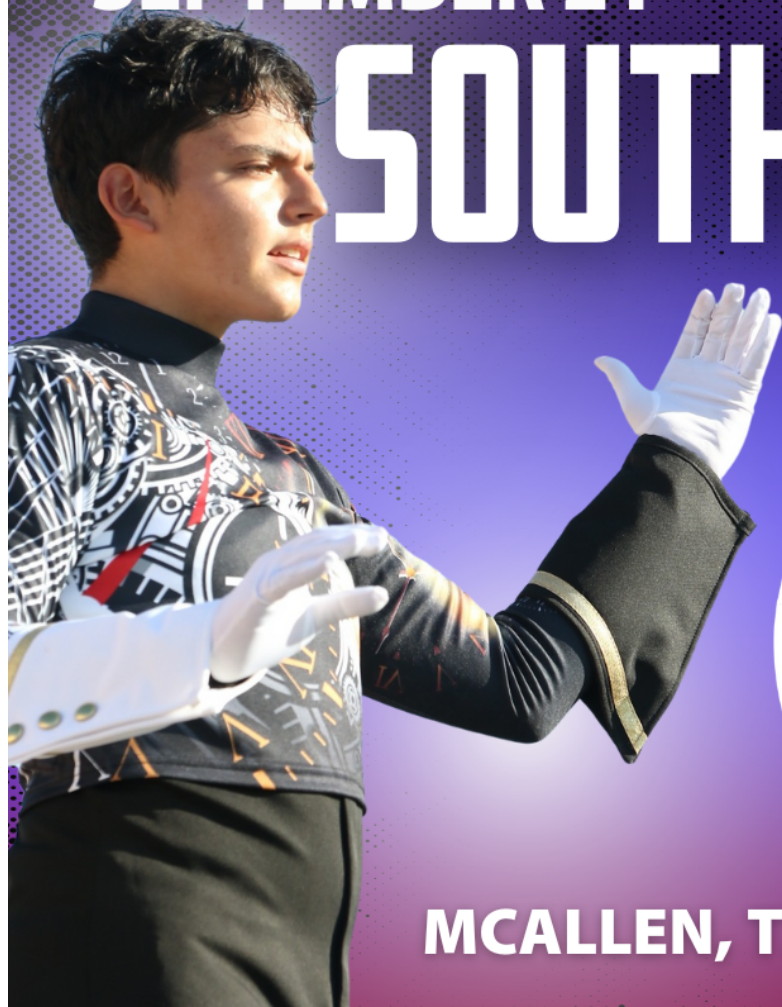
## **Spectator Parking**

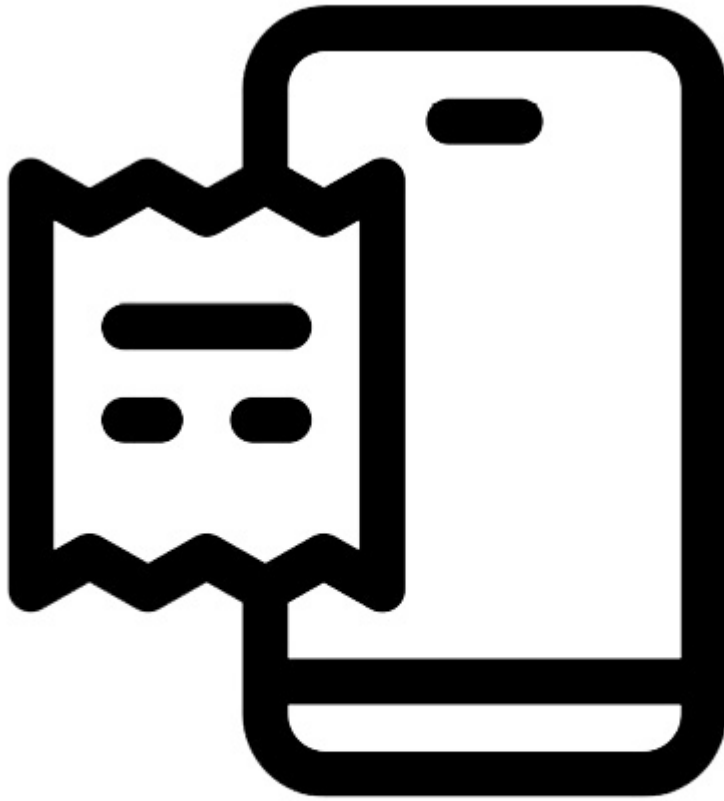

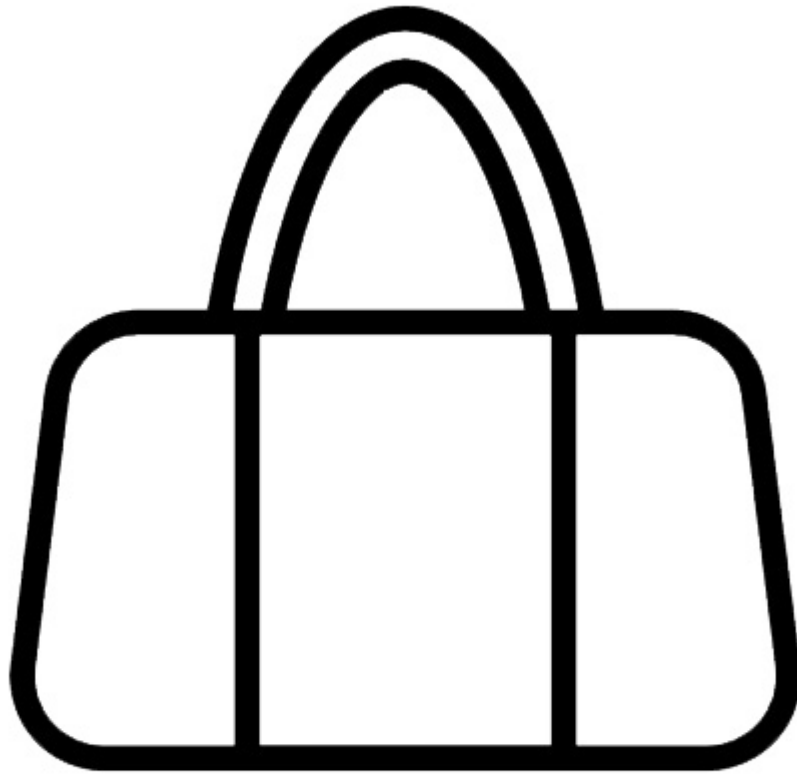

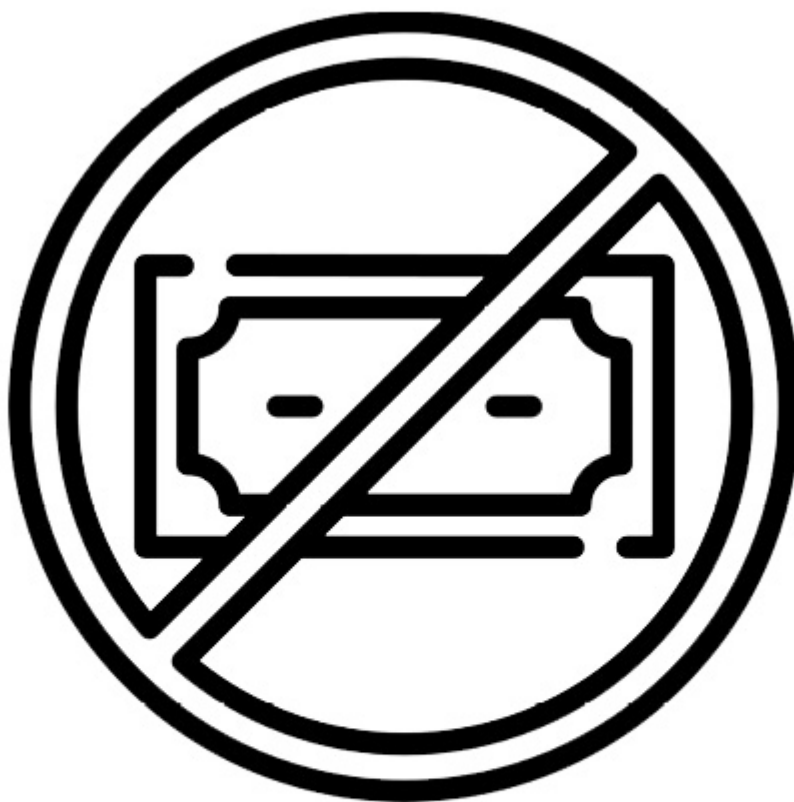
