GUEST GUIDELINES

Music for All will follow local requirements for safety and policies at the time of the event for spectators.


Video and audio recording of performances are not allowed. Video equipment will not be permitted in the stadium.

Photography: guests may photograph from the spectator seating areas, however, tripods or other similar equipment are not allowed in the stadium and may not be used. Guests arriving at the stadium entrance with a tripod or similar equipment will be asked to return it to their vehicle in order to enter the stadium.


Photos may not be taken from the field level, even with a field pass or director name badge. Music for All provides Media Passes for approved news media coverage.

RUTGERS ATHLETICS BAG POLICY



An exception will be made for **medically necessary items** after proper inspection at the Guest Services gates designated for this purpose.



SMALL CLUTCH NO LARGER THAN 4.5"x6.5" (APPROX. SIZE OF A HAND)

Prohibited bags include: purses larger than a clutch bag, coolers, briefcases, backpacks, fanny packs, cinch bags, luggage of any kind, computer bags and camera bags or any bag larger than the permissible size.

Prohibited items include: : outside food, bottles or beverage containers of any kind, alcoholic beverages, selfie sticks, balloons, balls, bottles, cans, containers, coolers, fireworks, laser pointers, noise making devices, pets, smoking, sticks/poles, strollers, umbrellas, weapons and other items deemed dangerous and/or inappropriate.

Also prohibited, by university representative, un-approved pamphlets, handouts, advertisements, rope, professional photography equipment (including GoPros).
