# ADULT CREDENTIALS

Upon checking in on-site, all bands will receive 6 director name badges valid for both prelims, semi-finals and finals, as well as 25 field passes (plus any additionally purchased passes), valid for prelims only. Bands performing in Semi Finals and Finals will receive a new set of 25 field passes (plus any additionally purchased passes) at the Semi Finalists and Finalist Directors' Meetings.

Additional Field Passes: All additional credentials must be purchased by November 12<sup>th</sup> by credit card only. The combination of additional name badges and field passes may not exceed 10. Of those 10, a maximum of 4 may be name badges. (BOA Adjudication Handbook Sections 6, 9, 14, 17).

# **ADJUDICATION PROCEDURES**

Music for All uses the CompetitionSuite adjudication system. In mid-September, you received an email from CompetitionSuite to create or update your profile. You can add members of your staff, cell phone numbers for text alerts, and other information to assist in receiving judge commentary from your performance. The following process remains in place:

• Approximately 90 minutes after your prelims performance, you will receive a text message to your primary director phone number letting you know that your commentary files are beginning to upload for you to review. You can then open up the CompetitionSuite phone/tablet application, visit the CompetitionSuite website, or call the number from which you received the text message to listen to your commentary.

• All scores (prelims, semi-finals, and finals) and recaps will be held until the end of the Finals Awards Ceremony. All scores and recaps will be available online via CompetitionSuite. No scores or recaps will be released prior to the conclusion of the Finals Awards Ceremony.

# PERFORMANCE SAFETY REMINDER

Per our rulebook, staging/props shall be limited to a maximum height of **12 feet tall**, including safety or other railings or equipment. Additionally, no participant may be on, or be placed on, any portion of any prop where the participant's feet are more than six feet above the playing surface of the stadium, unless appropriate safety railing and/or other safety equipment are in place and in use. Soft props that use air as an effect and are made of soft materials (streamers, fabric, inflatables, etc.) shall be limited to a maximum of **25 feet tall**.

**OVERNIGHT PARKING** - An Overnight Parking Permit may be purchased from MFA for \$50 per vehicle, valid ONLY for the EZ Park Lot (see the maps included in this packet). Parking is available beginning at 8pm Wednesday, November 14 through 6am Sunday, November 17. This pass may be purchased on-site at Band Check-In or in advance at grand-nationals-overnight-parking. All Overnight Parking Permits will be picked up at Band Check-In.

# EVENT DAY COMMUNICATIONS - BAND App

NEW this year: Music for All will be using the BAND app (instead of Remind) as our event day communications tool. We highly suggest that you download the app, a direct link for the private BAND group for the BOA Championship that you are participating in will be emailed to you prior to the event. Feel free to share the link with any relevant staff that you would like to have access to information such as schedule changes, weather updates, etc. **NOTE whoever you share the link with to join the BAND group will receive updates at the same time as you do, as well as have the ability to communicate directly with MFA event staff through the app.** 

# **BUS/EQUIPMENT TRUCK PARKING PASSES**

At the Grand National Championship, bus/truck parking passes complimentary. If you have not submitted a parking pass request, please complete the form immediately in order to receive your passes in time. Passes will be emailed upon completion of the form. Passes are required to enter the bus & truck unload/reload area and parking lots at the event. There is NO complimentary staff pass at Grand National Championships– all personal vehicles will need to park in a spectator lot.

# SPECATATOR PARKING

There is a **\$10** charge for spectator parking in the Lucas Oil South Lot at Grand Nationals. Spectator parking is also available around the stadium in local parking lots and garages. Please advise your parents and boosters to arrive early and allow extra time to get to the stadium, especially during peak times. Music for All does not control pricing or lot availability.
