DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION: OCTOBER 24, 2020

The Music for All Foundation is dedicated to creating, providing, and expanding positively life-changing experiences through music for all. The Foundation, formerly known as The Revelli Foundation and established in honor of Dr. William D. Revelli, has had a longstanding history of awarding scholarships. Dr. Revelli's legacy continues to live through the many students who benefit from the scholarships. These one-time awards honor students nominated by the directors of bands who performed at **one of the 2019 Bands of America Marching Championships or a 2020 Music for All virtual offering.**

The awards are made possible through generous gifts from Yamaha Corporation of America (\$1,000 Yamaha Scholarship) and the Fred J. Miller Family (\$1,000 Fred J. Miller Family Scholarship). **The scholarships will be announced and awarded by December 2020.**

Each school's band director may nominate two students from his/her band. Directors should complete the nomination form and return it with the required attachments to Music for All by OCTOBER 24, 2020.

Nominee Criteria

Nominees must be graduating seniors who:

- Plan to pursue a degree in music education.
- Demonstrate outstanding musicianship, leadership skills, and work ethic.
- Plan to enroll in college within one year of graduating high school.
- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent on other scales).
- Participated in one of the 2019 Bands of America Marching Championships or a 2020 Music for All virtual offering.

Nomination Submission Requirements

Each **STUDENT** must submit the following:

1. A résumé of musical and leadership achievements focusing **on all aspects** of the student's academic, musical, extracurricular, and community service accomplishments and demonstrating the **overall** quality of the candidate.
2. An essay of at least 500 but no more than 750 words that addresses each of the following prompts:
 - Please describe the experiences and/or people that have inspired you to become a music educator.
 - Why do you believe in music education, in music in your school, and in Music for All?
 - What traits do you feel are essential in a successful music educator, and how do you exemplify those traits?

Each **DIRECTOR** must complete the attached nomination form and submit the completed application (with student essay and résumé) to Music for All. **Directors should keep in mind that the quality of their responses will affect the overall application score.**
