

We are excited about your upcoming participation in the 2022 Rose Parade. Our first and foremost concern is the safety and health of all our participants. The Rose Parade and Rose Bowl Game have been classified as Mega Events with very specific COVID-19 protocols that need to be followed.

In cooperation with the City of Pasadena and the Pasadena Department of Health, participants in the Rose Parade must provide proof of vaccination or proof of a negative COVID-19 test result within 72 hours of the start of the parade. The attached document the full Summary of COVID-19 Compliance Requirements provided by the Tournament of Roses.

It is recommended, unless otherwise noted, that all participants and performers in the Rose Parade:

- Are vaccinated prior to participating and/or arriving in Southern California
- If unvaccinated:
 - Participant(s) are required to stay home if in close contact in the last 10 days with someone who had COVID-19; if vaccinated, get tested for COVID-19 3-5 days after last exposure.
 - **Participant(s) are required to provide the Music for All proof of negative COVID-19 test taken within 72 hours of student departure for California**
 - Participant(s) are required to provide the Association proof of negative COVID-19 test taken within 72 hours of the Rose Parade
 - Unvaccinated participants who do not provide a pre-event negative COVID-19 test **cannot participate** in any Association Mega Events including the Rose Parade, Rose Bowl Game and/or Floatfest
- Wear a mask in all indoor public settings, and at Outdoor Mega Events, regardless of vaccination; **approved performers/participants who provide proof of vaccination or a negative test taken within 72 hours of the Parade will not have to wear a mask while on the Parade route**
- Follow CDC requirements and recommendation for domestic travelers

In the next few days, you will receive an email from the Pasadena Tournament of Roses asking you to complete a waiver form by Dec. 1 and submit your proof of vaccination by Dec. 10, 2021.

If you are unable to provide proof of vaccination, we will follow up with instructions about how to provide your proof of a negative test result. **All testing is at the student/family expense.** The Association is setting up a testing site at or near Bandfest on December 29-30 to make testing available to those that are unvaccinated. Insurance information may be required and more information will be shared when available.

VIP EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

The Tournament of Roses Association and [Sharp Seating](#) are excited to welcome back fans to America's New Year Celebration at the 2022 Rose Parade & Its Events. We are closely following all guidelines put in place by Los Angeles County and the City of Pasadena's Health departments in order to maintain a safe and healthy environment for all event attendees.

With the current mandate in place, effective October 21, 2021, all patrons ages 12 years and older, **PARADE TICKET HOLDERS MUST BE PREPARED to show proof of full vaccination or a negative COVID-19 test (at your own expense) within 72 hours prior to attending the Rose Parade and its events.**

ALL INDOOR SPACES IN CALIFORNIA REQUIRE MASKS.

Health and safety requirements may vary by event. Please see the information below for planning and guidance.

- **Bandfest on 12/30/21**
 - Masks strongly encouraged, especially when cannot remain more than 6' from others outside your household
 - POV or negative COVID-19 test taken within 72 hours strongly encouraged

- **Rose Parade on 1/1/22**
 - Masks Required except when actively performing in the Parade
 - Proof of Vaccination or negative COVID-19 test taken within 72 hours
