PRELIM AWARDS CEREMONY

Lucas Oil Stadium - Indianapolis, IN



- This is a Drum Majors ONLY Awards ceremony.
 - Due to the large number of participants, color guard captains and other soloists will not be brought out onto the field with the drum majors.
- Drum majors should report to the **Missouri Street Loading Dock** in full uniform.
 - o BOA Staff will tell you the exact time as each band checks in at Band Check-In.
 - From the spectator areas, take the Northwest Ramp, outside Section 145, down to Event Level.
 - From outside the building, proceed down the Missouri Street ramp to the loading dock.
 - o From the Jolesch Photo Area/Band Exit take the Field Suite Stairs down to Event Level and take the west corridor to the dock (same path you took to warm-up). BOA Staff will be in place to guide you in the right direction.
- BOA Staff will check-in each school and give instructions for the ceremony.
 - We will walk with the Drum Majors and place them on the field.
 - Each student gets a tick mark 1 student per yard. Center of body on the tick mark.
 - o Every time your school's name is announced, step forward and give your salute.
 - Order of Awards: School Recognition Awards in performance order and Announcement of Semi-Finalists.
 - High Achievement Awards and Class Placement Awards will take place at the Semi-Finalist Awards Ceremony.
 - Please listen for the announcement of your school's name; don't assume that since the person next to you moved your school is next. ALL participating bands will be announced, even if they don't have representatives present.
 - After your salute, you'll be handed your recognition trophy. Step back in line, and place your trophy on the ground in front of you.
- After the announcement of Semi-Finalists, drum majors will be dismissed.
 - DIRECTORS Please create a plan with your drum majors and tell them where to come meet you and the rest of your band.




- This is a Drum Majors ONLY Awards ceremony.

 and take the west corridor to the dock (same path you took to warm-up). BOA Staff will

- After your salute, head towards the 50-yard line and meet the Awards presenter to collect your trophy and take a photo (High Achievement and Class Placement Awards).
 - o After the photo, return to the line. Place your trophy on the ground in front of you.
- After the announcement of Finalists, drum majors will be dismissed.
 - DIRECTORS Please create a plan with your drum majors and tell them where to come meet you and the rest of your band.

FINALS AWARDS CEREMONY





- This is a full band, Olympic style retreat with the 12 Finalist Bands, and any non-finalist Class Champion Bands.
 - At the Finalist Director's meeting, each band will be given a Retreat Map, with exact lineup locations and meeting times for each band.
 - Bringing your instruments and color guard equipment out onto the field is optional.
- Each band should report to their Finale Staging area in a single file line.
- BOA staff will be in each staging area to assist with the line up and give the line leaders final instructions.
- We will walk with the lines and bring them onto the field, across the back sideline.
- Line leaders will break away from the line at their assigned yard line, and head towards the front sideline.
- There will be a cone at the stopping point (top of the High School Numbers). This is where directors should enter the field and turn your line back into a block.
 - Blocks are to be no more than five yards wide. You can extend as far backfield as you need to.
- When all of the bands are on the field and the blocks have been built, we will begin the
 presentation of the medallions, followed by the Grand Nationals Video montage.
 - Directors and staff may distribute their National Finalist medallions to each student at this time.
 - Class Champions Students (named during the Semi-Finals Award Ceremony) will receive National Champion medallions.
- An announcement will be made for "Dum Majors Front and Center, please."
 - Drum majors and Color Guard captains should follow BOA Staff to form a condensed line, on the front sideline, centered on the 50-yard line. This is where the awards will be presented.
- Order of Awards:
 - Special Awards The following awards will be presented first in the ceremony if the recipients are not among the finalist bands. If the recipients are finalist bands, these awards will precede their placement award.
 - The Al Castronovo Memorial Esprit de Corps Award: This is a special award open to all Bands participating in Grand Nationals and is not based on any scores from the competition. The recipient is determined as the group that best exhibits pride, spirit, enthusiasm, friendliness, camaraderie, and unity of purpose for the marching band activity, as observed and evaluated by the Bands of America staff and volunteers throughout the weekend championship.
 - Invitation to the 2025 Rose Parade: The Tournament of Roses will be present at Grand Nationals and will select a band to invite to perform in the 2025 Rose Parade. The invitation will be extended to an eligible Semi-Finalist band that has indicated in advance via form response that they will accept the invitation if

extended. The announcement and invitation will be made during the Finals Awards Ceremony.

- Every time your school's name is announced, step forward and give your salute.
- After your salute, accept your trophy, center yourselves and take a photo with the awards presenter.
 - After the photo, return to your place in line. Place your trophy on the ground in front of you.
- After the announcement of the Grand National Champion, an announcement will be made for the bands to "Break Ranks".
 - This is a Bands of America tradition where all students may break to meet,
 acknowledge, and congratulate each other, as well as our new Bands of America Grand
 National Champion
 - o The next announcement will be made for students and staff to clear the field.
 - The Grand National Champion will be given the option to perform an encore performance.
 - DIRECTORS Please create a plan with your students prior to the awards ceremony on how you want them to exit the field. We welcome you to come up into the stands to watch the encore performance of the Grand National Champion, should they choose to do one.
