#### **HOTEL:**

### **Indianapolis Marriott Complex**

Exact hotel is TBD as all of the Grand National Bands and our block are still being finalized and placed.

#### **REHEARSAL VENUE:**

Indiana Convention Center 100 S. Capitol Ave. Indianapolis, IN 46225

**NOTE:** The hotel, rehearsal and performance location, and all meals are walkable. No additional on-site transportation is necessary.

#### **DATES**

Friday, November 14 - 5:00 PM through Sunday, November 16 - 2:00 PM Suggested Arrival - 3:00 PM.

Upon arrival, students will need to check-in with Music for All Staff, check into their hotel, and get their uniform fittings done by members of the FJM staff prior to the welcome meeting and rehearsal beginning at 7:00 PM.

#### TRAVEL TO INDIANAPOLIS

If you are flying to Indianapolis and require a shuttle, you should indicate this on the Percussion Weekend Registration Form.

<u>There are no physical shuttle tickets</u>. After deplaning, proceed to the bottom of the escalator at baggage claim. There will be a Bands of America representative to meet you.

If you are driving to Indianapolis, there is parking at the hotel complex (at member expense). There is a complementary parking lot closer to the stadium, but there is no overnight supervision, so parking is at your own risk. Parking passes and directions for this lot will be available at check-in. Students that drive themselves will have to surrender their keys for the duration of the weekend.

#### CHECK - IN HOURS: 10:00AM-6:00PM

When you arrive at the hotel, please proceed to the table in the lobby with the Music for All staff. We will check you in and provide your check-in packet with name tag.

If your room is not ready upon your arrival, a small luggage storage area will be available. For those students staying with family, a credit card WILL be required for incidentals on the room.

#### **GRAND NATIONALS FINALS TICKETS**

Each student will receive a finals ticket to get into the stadium and also a wristband to access field level to perform. Tickets for parents and family members will be in the same block with the students during finals.



# **Percussion Weekend Packing List**



#### REHEARSAL ITEMS

- Tennis shoes with proper arch support NO sandals or flip-flops
- Music, pencils
- White stick tape, drum key, practice pad
- Water bottle

#### **UNIFORM ITEMS**

- Tall white socks (we should not be able to see your ankles).
- Under uniform shorts and t-shirt (slim fitting; not baggy)
  - SHORTS: mid-thigh/boxer length shorts. No basketball shorts. Under armor is typical.
  - o T-SHIRT

NOTE: these items should be tan or other natural colors, light grey, or light blue. Do NOT wear white, dark colors, or anything with a design as it will show under the uniform.

#### PERSONAL ITEMS

- Toiletries and necessities (toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, conditioner, soap, deodorant, feminine products, glasses/contact solution/contact case, orthodontic needs)
- Hair-care items (brush, comb, gel, spray, pins, elastic, etc.)
- Prescriptions (if needed).
  - NOTE: Medicines must be in the original bottle with dosage amounts defined.
- Spending money for souvenirs and/or additional snacks (a suggested amount would be \$25-\$75)

## **Bands of America will provide:**

- All percussion instruments with sticks and mallets
- Music stands
- Performance uniform and white shoes
- Chaperone supervision of all students throughout the weekend, including room checks at lights out
