Physical Preparedness- We know that it's a break from school and your normal lives, but keeping your body moving is the only way you can guarantee that you'll be able to march the full length of the parade. Even though the parade is advertised as 5.5 miles long, from the starting line to the finish point is closer to 7 miles. That's 12,320 yards, or 19,712 – 8 to 5 steps.

If band members must drop out of the parade, for whatever reason, they will not be allowed to rejoin the band, per the Tournament of Roses policy. Therefore, we encourage you to keep your body moving this week!
